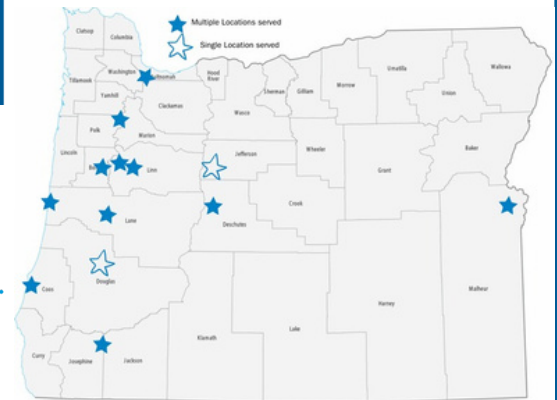
The Club Experience

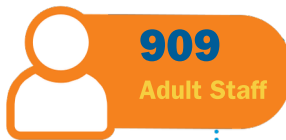

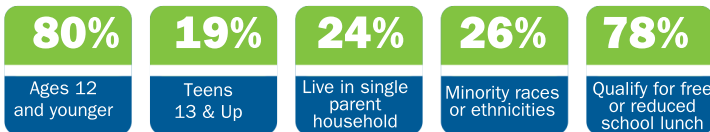
The Need In Our State: Every day **131,779**

Leaders in Out-Of-School Time

Clubs provide young people with a safe place, caring adult mentors, fun, friendship, and high-impact activities on a daily basis during critical non-school hours. Club programs provide high-quality out-of-school time programs cultivating dynamic engagement & skills that support whole child well-being and student improvement.

Our Impact

78% of Club members indicate they have a strong adult connection with staff at their Club.
Club members in 8th, 10th and 12th grades volunteer at significantly higher rates than their peers nationally. **



Safer Childhoods

Every young person has a right to a safe, positive environment in which to learn and grow. Boys & Girls Clubs are committed to supporting communities and ensuring the safety of all youth especially when youth are not in school.

Our Impact

90% of Club members say they could go to staff for help in a crisis.
83% of Club members feel like they can stand up for what they think is right, even if their friends disagree.



Health & Wellness

Every young person should be equipped to make healthy decisions resulting in positive social, emotional, and physical well-being. Club members learn foundational skills like how to manage stress and demonstrate good teamwork, enabling youth to make healthy decisions, avoid risky behaviors and connect with their peers.

Our Impact

Club teens are less likely to use drugs or alcohol and more likely to engage in regular physical activity than their peers nationally. **
82% of Club Members indicate a very high avoidance of risky behaviors.



Education, Workforce & Leadership

Clubs equip youth with the essential skills they need to succeed, creating access to real-life experiences and exploring career options. When young people perform well academically, they graduate from high school on time, and have a plan to succeed in today's workforce. Club youth are the leaders, innovators and problem-solvers of tomorrow.

Our Impact

71% of Club members say adults at the Club always encourage them to do their best.
Club members ages 12 to 17 living in low income households, report higher grades than non-member peers nationally. **



Diversity, Equity & Inclusion

Every young person has the right to safe, positive and inclusive environments where everyone can reach their full potential. The mission and core beliefs of Boys & Girls Clubs fuel our commitment to promoting safe, positive and inclusive environments for all.

Our Impact

Clubs celebrate the strengths of their members and communities.
80% of Club members report a high sense of emotional safety in their program.
